Proposed extensions to and remodelling of the existing clubhouse; alterations to the existing car park and provision of additional car parking to the north of the clubhouse; demolition of existing agricultural building and construction of additional earth bunds to the east of the existing bunds with associated landscaping and other ancillary works including shooting shelters and 4.5m high towers. Shooting operations only to be during the following hours and days; Monday, 0900-1800hrs, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 0900 - 1800 hrs; Wednesday and Friday 0900-2100hrs; and no Sundays. The Parish Council had received 4 emails in support of the application, and 25 emails of objection and 17 members of the public attended the meeting to voice their concerns about the application. As a statutory consultee the Parish Council **resolved** to object to this planning application. Although the Council had no objection to the extension of the existing clubhouse, they object strongly to any extension to shooting hours and object strongly to any further bunding.
