TRAFFIC AND ROAD SAFETY

- Our roads are already overwhelmed Ashlawn Road,
 Hillmorton Road, High Street, and Crick Road are gridlocked daily.
- Six serious collisions in just six months including one fatal.
- Every extra car adds to the daily risk protect our children, families and older members of our community.

UNSAFE ROADS: BARBY LANE & KILSBY LANE

- Not designed for heavy traffic narrow, no proper footpaths, already dangerous.
- More vehicles will make these routes even more treacherous for walkers, cyclists, and families.

PRESSURE ON LOCAL SCHOOLS

- Hillmorton's schools are already stretched to breaking point.
- Even planned expansions will NOT cope with the extra pressure.
- More families will face school place shortages, pushing children miles away from their own community.

NOT ENOUGH LOCAL AMENITIES

- We will be left fighting for appointments, services, and basic resources - this is not sustainable.


PERMANENT DAMAGE TO OUR ENVIRONMENT
