No Mow May The Parish Council received a mix of feedback following its participation in the No Mow May initiative for the first time. The Parish Council will consider all feedback before making a decision as to whether to participate again next year.

<u>Overgrown Vegetation</u> At this time of year the Parish Council commonly receives an increase in complaints about overgrown vegetation impinging on the roads or footpaths. Hedges and other vegetation are the responsibility of the landowner and the Parish Council would kindly ask all residents in the Parish to check for any overgrowing vegetation that might be impinging on footpaths or roads and take measures to cut these back. If you think a hedge or tree is the responsibility of West Northamptonshire Council then this can be reported directly to them on the reporting website 'Fix My Street': <u>https://www.fixmystreet.com/</u>

Discounted food liners to boost food waste recycling Discounted food caddy liners are available from libraries across West Northamptonshire as part of a drive to encourage food waste recycling; buy a roll of 30 bags for £1. Food waste from West Northamptonshire is currently taken to an anaerobic digester facility at either Cassington in Oxfordshire or Coleshill near Birmingham. The food is then broken down by bacteria, as it would be in our stomachs - producing fertiliser and methane gas which is burned to generate electricity. Any bags are removed as part of this recycling process, so people can use any old plastic bag to line their caddy, so long as its not black. Newspaper can also be used as a liner.
