The editor of the newsletter advised that the next deadline is 25th January 2026. ii. A member of the public spoke regarding upcoming road closures by Anglian Water and the impact on bin collections. They advised that they had been in contact with West Northamptonshire Council to notify them of the issue. iii. A member of the public spoke about speeding on Daventry Road and it was agreed that Cllr O'Reilly would send the details of who to contact at West Northamptonshire Council.

5.1	To approve and sign the Minutes of 8th December 25 (A): It was RESOLVED to approve the minutes of 8 th December 2025 which were duly signed by the Chair.

Cllr Gorman reported that the planning officer had advised that the final report being awaited was submitted on 8th January regarding the Barby Sporting Club application and the earliest the planning officer's report is expected is mid-February. ii. Cllr Gorman reported that she had been in contact with the Housing Association and residents regarding the School Close planning application and they had shared the title deeds which confirm that the developer has access rights through the site but not

	<p>necessarily a right to access the existing foul drainage and pump. She reported that a meeting to discuss this was being arranged. She also reported that there was a query as to why School Close had not been adopted.</p> <p>iii. Cllr Gorman reported that there had been no response yet from Balfour Beatty regarding the cost of removing the flag.</p> <p>iv. Cllr Gorman reported that there had been no further response regarding the D1 bus route from the bus company.</p> <p>v. Cllr Gorman reported that Barby Lane will be closed on 6th April for work to re-surface Normans Bridge.</p> <p>vi. It was reported that the path to Onley Village Hall had been completed and it was agreed that Cllr Gorman would write to Wates, who had carried out the work, on behalf of the Parish Council to thank them and ask if they are able to fund anything else for the Parish.</p>

9.1	To receive update from working group regarding Onley Playground refurbishment: It was noted that the third quote had not been received. It was agreed that Cllr Withington, Cllr Benton and Cllr Cotton would arrange a public consultation meeting.
9.2	To receive update and agree any actions regarding water pipe replacement and charging for water: Cllr Gorman reported that she had contact details for the person at the MOJ who was responsible for the contract and there was no further update at present.
9.3	To receive update and agree any actions regarding overgrown hedge outside prison mess hall: It was reported that the hedge was on Parish Council owned land and that the Clerk would advise the mowing contractor that keeping pathways clear of vegetation was part of the mowing contract. It was agreed to ask Lamley Brothers if they would extend their contract by a year at the same cost.
9.4	To consider purchase of additional grit bins and grit for Onley: It was agreed to defer this item to allow additional time to consider the quotes.
9.5	To receive update on additional defibrillators for Onley and agree any actions: It was reported that the 'OurJay' charity had advised that they could provide discounts but not full funding for defibrillators. It was agreed explore the cost of defibrillators and to consider this further at the next meeting.

10.1	To receive litter picking report: It was reported that 4 bags of litter were collected in December.

11.1	To note correspondence from resident regarding EC6 footpath: The correspondence published with the agenda was noted.

12.1	To consider any actions regarding West Northamptonshire local plan: It was reported that the draft WNC local plan provides for 58 additional houses in Barby up to 2043 and that more clarification is needed on this. It was reported that a query has been raised as to how the figures have been obtained.
12.2	To consider any actions regarding Rugby local plan: It was reported that the Rugby local plan provided for houses on brownfield sites and a site opposite Houlton and there we no plans to go ahead with building on the Lodge Farm site or Barby Lane, Hilmorton site. It was agreed that Cllr Gorman would write to the conservative councillors to ask that they support the proposed local plan or abstain from the vote.
13	FLOODING
13.1	To receive update and agree any actions regarding water leak in Church Walk: Cllr Gorman reported that there was another leak on Church Walk which has been reported on Fix My Street. She reported that WNC had advised that they would look into repair work if the Parish Council is willing to contribute towards the cost. It was RESOLVED that the Parish Council would contribute up to £2,000 towards drainage works on Church Walk.
